

Preface


The Students' Satisfaction Index (SSI) is a quantified feedback of students on the course.






Total there are 34 questions where the students have submitted their feedback. 1743 (62 %) students have submitted the survey on GNOMIO.




















Above bar charts are shown for SSI of SE, TE and BE class with average out of 5 scale for all departments.

Students (% SE, TE, BE) from following Departments participated: Civil Engineering (91%, 86%, 49%), Computer Engineering (80%, 74%, 73%), Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering (69%, 75%, 46%), Information Technology (81%, 76%, 42%), Mechanical Engineering (61%, 51%, 45%), Instrumentation and Control Engineering (35%, 26%, 25%), Production Engineering (33%, 24%, --) have participated in the survey.

Blue bars indicate the Average Students Satisfaction Index (SSI) and Red bars indicate factored SSI and computed as: SSI x (Total Students Participated in Students' Exit Survey/Total Strength of Student in that Year). Average SSI of the Institute is 4.45 (2.76) out of 5.
