“Eye Checkup Camp”

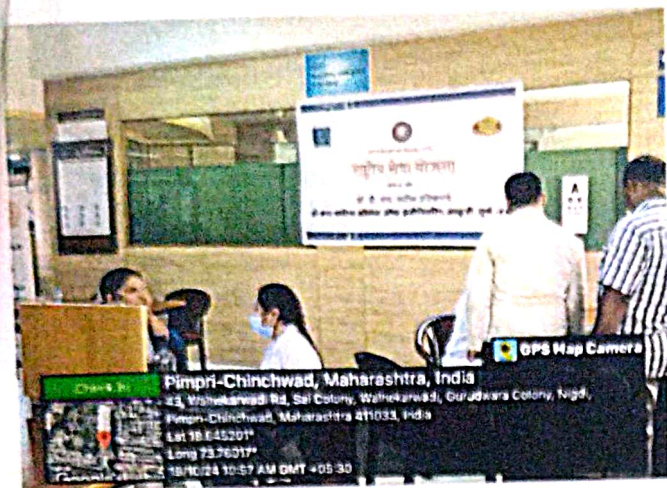
Objective:


